












Message From Executive Trustee



The Micro-Teaching concept was introduced from January 2022. All the teachers participated and delivered one or more micro-teaching module.



Lalji Mehrotra Technical Institute

Lalji Mehrotra Technical Institute is a training hub offering a number of skill oriented programs through its Industrial Training Institute, Vocational Training Institute and Skill Development Institute. There have been operational challenges for 2 years due to the pandemic which led to the previous academic year 2020 – 21 getting extended up to December, 2021. This subsequently affected the regular session of 2021 – 22 which started in January, 2022. Despite the adverse situation the entire staff of the Institute worked towards providing good quality of training and at the same time enrolled and trained 450 students during the academic year 2021 – 22.

INTRODUCTION OF DUAL SYSTEM OF TRAINING


To bridge the gap between the ITI training given to the trainees and the industry requirement, the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) introduced the scheme of "Dual System of Training" (DST) in India. The DST is the amalgamation of theoretical training imparted through ITIs and practical training imparted through industry. This is a German model of training introduced in LMTI with the approval from Government of India, Notification dated, 23/12/2021.

The LMTI industry partners are JSW Steel Coated Product Limited, Protolab Electrotechnologies Pvt. Ltd., Kapadia Brothers, Hiver Aircon Pvt. Ltd., SARA HVAC Pvt. Ltd., Vecare Consumers Science Pvt. Ltd. 136 trainees per year will be trained under this innovative scheme during the project period 2021 – 2026 for enhancing the employability and meeting the industrial demand for increasing productivity.

INTRODUCTION OF EMERGING TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENTS IN LAB

Institute has introduced Internet of Things (IoT) based Domestic Appliances like House Lighting, CCTV, Smart TV, Washing Machine for Electronics Mechanic, Technician Power Electronics System & Electrician trade labs which happens to be one of the first few in ITI's in the country.

Godrej & Boyce Manufacturing Company Limited, Security Solution Division has donated CCTV setup for IoT Lab for practical training. Similarly, IoT based appliances have been donated by Reliance Retails Pvt. Ltd., who are our Industry Partners.



INDUSTRY DEMAND DRIVEN CUSTOMIZED TRAINING FOR ENGINEERS & TECHNICIANS

Hitachi ATM / CRM Engineers across the country have been trained at Mumbai, Chennai & Delhi on Multi Skill of UPS, Inverter, Power Supply, Split AC, E – Surveillance by our Trainers. A special training kit was designed and manufactured to suit their operational requirement. A total of 184 engineers & technicians were trained by us.

Anchor – Panasonic customized training program for field electrical technicians was conducted at the Institute. The training content was designed jointly by Anchor – Panasonic experts and Electrical Trade faculties of the Institute and successfully delivered training to 104 participants.

INSTRUCTOR TRAINING FOR OTHER INSTITUTE

LMTI Gurugram became operational for imparting training in Allied Healthcare segment. It signed MOUs with various hospitals and healthcare centres for internships & placement of its students.

The centre obtained accreditation by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) under Ministry of Skill Development & Entreneurship and Healthcare Sector Skill Council for Emergency Medical Technician Course. The Center enrolled 72 students in its first year of operation.


CONSTRUCTION OF NEW LABS OF BOTANY, CHEMISTRY AND ZOOLOGY.




